WHEN SOMEONE PASSES AWAY

When someone passes away, there are several steps that need to be taken care of.

If your loved one dies at home: Getting the Medical Certificate

The first step is to contact their doctor. Thereafter, you will need to contact us as your chosen funeral director to arrange bringing your loved one into our care. All deaths must now be reviewed by an independent medical examiner before the doctor can issue the Medical Certificate of Cause of Death, unless the coroner needs to be involved.

If the death is referred to the coroner

A post-mortem may need to take place which will take a bit longer. If this is the case, contact us and we will talk you through the next steps.

If your loved one dies elsewhere:

In Hospital: The bereavement services department of the hospital will assist you in obtaining the Medical Certificate of Cause of Death via the hospital. Your loved one will remain in the hospital mortuary until the death has been registered. Once this has taken place, we will make arrangements to convey your loved one into our care.

Care Home or Hospice: The staff of the hospice or nursing home will support you in obtaining the Medical Certificate of Cause of Death and will care for your loved one until they are conveyed to our funeral home in a dignified and caring manner. Contact us so we can advise on the next steps.

On holiday or outside of the UK: If this occurs, contact us as soon as possible and we can arrange for repatriation to bring your loved one back home.

Who can register the death?

Death is usually registered by the next of kin or a relative of the deceased. Alternatively, this can be done by the person who was with the deceased at the time of their death or the person who is arranging the funeral.

What to prepare: What documents do I need for death registration?

Contact the registrar who will make an appointment to register the death. They will need certain key information including:

- Full name, gender, date and country of birth
- Occupation: current or previous
- Address and postcode
- Parental names and occupations
- Marital status with partner(s) name, date of birth and occupation

What documents to expect:

Once the registration has taken place, the death certificate will be handed to you, or sent by post. You will also be given a “Green Form” to hand over to us or the registrar may elect to email this to us directly. We will take care of everything else from then on. If a post-mortem has been carried out, the coroner will issue the correct forms directly to us, as your chosen funeral director.

TELL US ONCE

Tell Us Once is a service that lets you report a death to most government organisations in one go.

Tell Us Once will notify:

- HM Revenue and Customs (HMRC)
- Department for Work and Pensions (DWP)
- Passport Office • Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency (DVLA) • The Local Council • Veterans UK

We recommend using the ‘Tell Us Once’ service available through GOV.UK. This allows you to report a death to most government organisations in one go. If you have any other questions, please call us.

BEFORE THE FUNERAL

It’s almost impossible to be fully prepared when the time comes, however, there are a few things you need to consider when planning the funeral.

Burial or Cremation

A key decision is whether to arrange a burial or cremation.

If you know what the deceased wanted, let us know. If you are unsure, you may wish to check their will or expression of wishes or talk to friends and other family members. You must also check if the deceased had taken out a funeral plan.

Religious or non-religious service

Another important consideration is whether the deceased was religious or a member of a specific place of worship.

You would likely want to arrange the funeral following their faith; if so, please do let us know.

Repatriation

If your loved one passes away whilst abroad, they can be repatriated back to their home country if needed. Repatriation can be to and from the UK.

We offer guidance and help throughout the entire repatriation process to ensure that your loved one is brought back home to be buried or cremated.

DAY OF THE FUNERAL

This is the day you pay a unique tribute to the life of your loved one.

Funeral Procession

On the day itself, we will arrive at our agreed meeting point in good time so you can view any floral tributes before leaving for the service. Family and friends who are traveling in our funeral limousines will need to arrive at the agreed location before we start the procession. On arrival at the funeral venue, our professional pallbearers or your loved one's family and friends will escort the coffin with dignity and respect into the service hall led by our funeral director.

Funeral Ceremony

The ceremony will start at the time booked, following the pre-arranged order of service. Every ceremony is completely unique to every family. Traditionally, close family will sit in the first few rows, however you can arrange to be seated as you would like. Following a cremation service, we will show you to the area where the flowers and floral tributes will be placed.

Burial or Cremation

If you have held the service at a separate place of worship prior to burial or cremation, we will escort you to the next destination for the committal. Burial Services will differ according to location.

Wake (reception)

Many families choose to hold a catered reception following the funeral. Friends and family come together to reminisce and celebrate the life of the deceased. You can organise the reception at your home or at another venue, it is up to you.

AFTER THE FUNERAL

After the funeral service, many families choose to commemorate their loved ones by having a memorial or keepsake to keep their memories alive. If you'd like to do something special after the service do let us know – we're happy to help!

Following a Cremation

If we have arranged a cremation service for you, we can arrange to collect the ashes on your behalf free of charge and hold them in our care until you decide what you would like to do. Many families choose to commemorate the ashes immediately, others prefer waiting until a special day or an opportunity when the entire family can come together. Should you wish to keep your loved one's ashes with you, we have a selected range of urns available to keep the ashes safe in your home as well as a range of keepsakes and ashes and fingerprint jewellery.

Following a burial

If your loved one was buried, it can take 6-12 months for the grave to settle. This means organising a fitting memorial headstone needs consideration well in advance. Please give us a call and we'd be more than happy to answer any questions you may have. We're here for you.

Funeral Plans



A funeral plan is an easy way to arrange the funeral you want in advance. A plan allows you to specify your wishes and pay for the funeral director's services included in your plan. FAQ's

(Q). How Many People Can Be Seated In The Limousine ?

(A). In each limousine there is room for six people in the rear compartment.

(Q). How Do We Know What To Do At The Funeral ?

(A). On the day of the funeral we are there to help and guide you, your family and friends. If you are unsure of anything please tell the Funeral Director.

(Q). Can The Family Carry The Coffin ?

(A). Yes, although we would ask that you contact us as soon as possible to ensure that it is safe to do so.

(Q). Can We Visit The Deceased And Pay Our Last Respects ?

(A). Yes, our Funeral Home is available to you by appointment.

If you wish to visit our private chapel, please ring and inform us when you would like to come and we will be pleased to arrange for a member of staff to meet you.

(Q). Can We Have The Deceased Brought Home ?

(A). Yes, we can bring the deceased home either on the evening before the service or the morning of the service.

(Q). Can We Choose What Music Is Played ?

(A). Yes, If you have a special request or would like a particular piece of music playing either as you walk into or out of the Crematorium Chapel, please let the Funeral Director know.

(Q). Can We Request Donations To Charity ?

(A). Yes, if donations to charity are requested in lieu of flowers, we will accept and list donations on your behalf using an online payment facility. Any received in branch will be forwarded to the charity of your choice.

(Q). Does The Coffin Move After The Funeral Service ?

(A). No. After the service has ended, the coffin does not move until all relatives and friends have left the Crematorium Chapel. It is the family's choice whether the curtains remain open or closed as mourners leave the chapel.

(Q). Are Handles On The Coffin Removed Before Cremation ?

(A). No. There are strict laws regarding cremation. Nothing may be removed from the coffin before cremation without the permission of the Home Office.

(Q). Is Each Cremation Carried Out Individually ?

(A). Yes. The identity of the coffin name plate is checked by the Crematorium Attendant before it is placed in the Cremation Chamber. This only holds one coffin or casket at a time and again there are rules that must be abided by.

(Q). Do I Get Cremated Remains Back That Belong To Me ?

(A). Yes. Once the cremation has taken place, the cremated remains are removed and left to cool before being placed in an urn. This urn is clearly identified as to whose remains they are.

(Q). What Can I Do With The Cremated Remains ?

1. You can place them in the Garden of Remembrance but you may not know their exact location and thus may not be able to place a headstone with them.
2. You may wish to purchase a small burial plot just for the purpose of interring the cremated remains. This allows you to have a headstone and have the remains of other family members buried there in the future.
3. You may keep them at home in a special urn or memorial.
4. You may scatter them in a special place.
5. 5. The remains may be buried in an existing family grave.

Choosing a Memorial

A memorial is a special way to honour and remember a loved one.

It serves as a physical reminder of the person who has passed away and offers a place for family and friends to visit, grieve, and reflect on their loss. Here's a concise guide to help you choose the perfect memorial.

The difference between a headstone and a marker

A headstone is an upright monument that marks the burial place and typically includes personal information and a quote. A marker is a flat plaque placed on a stone base and is only readable from above. It is usually used in specific areas of cemeteries or churchyards.

Best Headstone Material

Commonly used materials for memorials in the UK include:

- Granite (tough, durable and comes in various colours and finishes)
- Marble (natural beauty, but not allowed in all churchyards)
- Limestone (allowed in most churchyards and cemeteries)
- Sandstone (e.g. Yorkshire & Serena, usable in both churchyards & cemeteries)
- Slate (easy to carve, suitable for churchyards and cemeteries)

Writing on a Headstone

An epitaph, a short quote or saying, is a unique and important part of a headstone.

Tips for writing an epitaph

Keep it concise, limited to a few lines. It can be from the perspective of the deceased, a relative, or a friend. Be respectful, as many people will read these words. Make it timeless, considering it will be there permanently.

Tombstone Quote

A tombstone quote includes personal details such as the name, birth date, and death date, along with a short message.

Headstone Pricing

Prices will vary depending on the material and inscription. As a rough guide:

- Granite is relatively cheaper (£)
- Marble, Limestone, and Sandstone are moderately priced (££)
- Slate tends to be more expensive (£££)

When to Put Up a Headstone

In most cases, you should wait around six months after a burial funeral service to allow the ground to settle. This does not apply to cremation memorials. If you need further assistance, don't hesitate to get in touch with us for more advice.

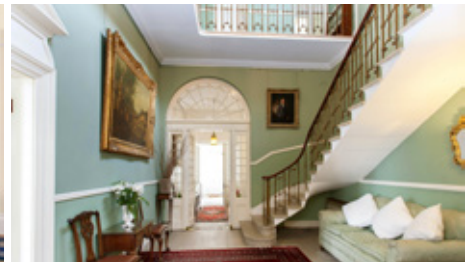

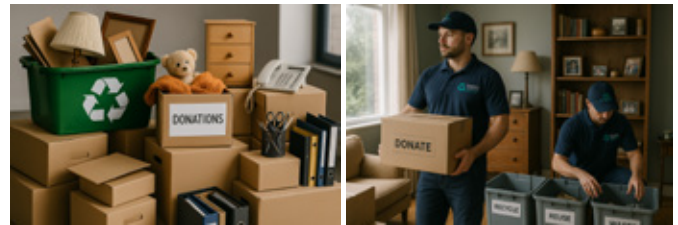
